COMPLIANCE OF PROCEEDINGS OF IQAC MEETING HELD ON 21.09.2016

Syndicate considered and approved proceedings of the IQAC meeting held on 21.09.16 vide Syndicate Resolution No. 110 of the Syndicate meeting held on 23.09.2016. IQAC proceeding is circulated vide Letter No. 7260/IQAC dated 27.09.2016.

Compliance of Item No. 1:

1. University authority has advertised to fill up the vacant teaching posts of the University vide advertisement number 1626,1629,1632, 1635, 1638, 1641, 1644, 1647, 1650, 1653, 1656, 1659, 1662, 1665 and 1668/Estt III dated 27.02.2017.

Compliance of Item No. 2.

2. An Industry-Interface Cell under the chairmanship of the Director, SRIC is constituted. The Departments are advised to interact with technical and management personnel of the local industries for research collaboration and other purposes.

Compliance of Item No. 3.

3. University authority has advertised the post of 'Placement Officer' vide advertisement number 9757/Estt-I dt.20.12.2016 and its recruitment will be made shortly. The interview will be held on 5th and 6th May, 2017.

Compliance of Item No. 4.

4. Inter-departmental collaboration through interdisciplinary research has been encouraged at all levels. A number of inter- and intra- departmental seminars, conferences, symposia, workshops were organized in the academic session 2016-17.

Compliance of Item No. 5.

5. A decision was taken in the Syndicate to institute Research awards for the best performing Department, Teacher and Research Scholar for their outstanding contribution in research every year in two separate faculties namely, 1. Science 2. Humanities & Social Sciences has been ratified in Syndicate vide Syndicate Resolution Nos. 112 dated 23.09.2016. The sub-committee was constituted to devise (a) duration of research for consideration of award (b) application format, (b) guidelines for award, (c) marking pattern and (d) format of certificate of award.

Compliance of Item No. 6.

6. One new PG Department namely Department of Biotechnology and Bioinformatics has been opened vide Syndicate Resolution No. 111 dated 23.09.2016 and PGCO Office Order No.9285/Estt-III dated 07.12.2016.

New PG Department namely Department of Sanskrit has been opened vide Syndicate Resolution No. 115 (1) dated 23.02.2017. Advertisement for admission into PG programme in Sanskrit for 2017-18 has been made vide PGCO Notification No. 36/PGCO/20.04.2017.

Compliance of Item No. 7.

7. A decision was taken in the Syndicate to make separate annual Budget Head of Rs.50 lakhs to support e-Governance of the University and of Rs.4 lakhs for legal expenses vide Syndicate Resolution Nos. 114 dated 23.09.2016. Provision has already been made in Revised Estimate (2016-17) and Budget Estimate (2017-18) by the office of the Comptroller of Finance of the University.

8. The departments have been encouraged to apply for autonomy.

9. HRDC has been assigned to render training programmes in a regular interval for all the ministerial and technical staff of the University.

10. A market oriented self financing Masters Course on Agri-Business in the Department of Business Administration is introduced vide Syndicate Resolution No. 115 (4) dated 23.09.2016. Advertisement for admission into Masters Course on Agri-Business for 2017-18 has been made vide PGCO Notification No. 36/PGCO/20.04.2017.
