Forwarding of correction slip No. 1/2018 regarding amendment of the regulation for the Bachelor of Arts, Science and Commerce Examinations (Three-year Degree Course) Under Choice Based system (CBCS).

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to forward herewith the correction slip No. 1/2018 regarding amendment of the regulation for the Bachelor of Arts, Science and Commerce Examinations (Three-year Degree Course) Under Choice Based system (CBCS) for favour of your kind information and necessary action.

C.S. No. 1/2018

That the following amendments are made in the regulation for the Bachelor of Arts, Science and Commerce Examinations (Three-year Degree Course) Under Choice Based system (CBCS).

(1) That in the provision 1:4 regarding Generic Elective Course, the words "Again, He or She shall choose one Generic Elective Course of 4 papers other than the Honours subject from Appendix -A (for Arts) & Appendix -C (For Science)" be deleted and substituted by the following:

"Again, He or She shall choose one/two Generic Elective Course of 4 papers / 2 papers each other than the Honours subject from Appendix -A (For Arts) and Appendix - C (For Science). Further, in the course structure for B.A./B.Sc./B.Com.(Honours) under head "Choices Offered" in second line, the following words, "1(One)/2(Two) Generic Elective Course from the list of subjects other than the course chosen for specific core courses (4 papers for GE)" are substituted for, "1(One) Generic Elective Course from the list of subjects other than the course chosen for specific core courses (4 papers for GE)". Moreover, at Appendix- A and Appendix -C (Subject Choice Template (for Arts and Science Honours) G.E. other than Honours be read as (Any One/Two).

(2) The provision 4.6 "Scheme of Examination regarding question pattern and distribution of marks shall be formulated by the respective Board of Studies. Moreover, the questions should cover the entire syllabus and preferably should contain both objective and subjective questions from each unit" be deleted and substituted by the following:

(3) Further the separate provision i.e. 4.6.1 be inserted with the following provision in it.
4.6.1 The duration of all Examination shall be 03 hours irrespective of papers. Practical will be of 03 hours duration. The marking pattern for end-term Examination shall be as follows:-

NB- The following authority is responsible for maintaining the provable records of internal assessment examination. the internal examination shall be done by the college with proper/ timely notification which shall be completed before end of the semester.

(4) (i) The provision 5.4.1, "In order to pass any theory component a candidate is required to secure a minimum of "P" grade" be deleted and be substituted by "**in order to pass any paper component a candidate is required to secure a minimum of "P" grade**".

(ii) The provision 5.4.2, "in order to pass any practical/ tutorial component is required to secure a minimum of "P" grade" be deleted and replaced by "**the passing criteria shall be calculated taking theory & tutorial/ practical taken together. However student remaining absent in any of the component i.e. End semester theory, internal assessment/ practical shall be declared fail on that paper**".

(iii) In provision 5.4.3, "In order to clear a Semester examination a candidate is required to pass in all theory and practical/ tutorial components of the semester" be deleted and replaced by "**In order to clear a Semester examination a candidate is required to pass in all papers of the semester**".


(5) The provision 6.1, "A candidate failing to pass and has obtained "F" grade in theory of practical/ tutorial component of any paper of a semester examination may be allowed to re-appear only in that component of the paper at next examination for that semester" be deleted and replaced by "**A candidate failing to pass and has obtained "F" grade in any paper of a semester examination may be allowed to re-appear only in that paper (in both theory & practical(if any)) at next examination for that semester (no need to send internal marks in case of re-appearance)**".

(6) The subject of "Intellectual Property Rights", "NCC" and "Red Cross" be incorporated in the option for SEC-C in B.A.(Pass) in addition to the Skill Paper of GE.

(7) The clause 1.3. (Tables of Course Structure 3 nos.) for all courses be replaced as per the Appendix- A (3 tables).


