NOTIFICATION

It is for information of all concerned that the Vice-Chancellor in exercise of his power vested under sub section 15 of section 6 of the Odisha Universities Act. 1989 has been pleased to approve the recommendation of the members of Multi Disciplinary Board of studies as follows.

1. DSE-4 paper at U.G. level shall be the research based project paper for all Departments/Discipline.
2. Research project shall be a compulsory paper of 6(Six) credits at U.G. level in final semester and will be effective from the final year examination of 2022, and onwards. The six credit paper shall be evaluated for 100 marks. Comprising of 60 marks for dissertation; 20 marks for open vive-voce test before the teachers of the department and 20 marks for theory examination on research methodology to be conducted internally by the Department. One representative of the Principal should be present in the open vive-voce test. However, for the final year examination of 2022, the evaluation shall be conducted for 60 marks Dissertation and 20 marks for open vive-voce test which will be rationalised to a total of 100 marks at University level.
3. The syllabus for theory component on Research methodology for a particular subject area/discipline may be developed by the teachers of the Department. For this, the research methodology syllabus for Economics at U.G. level Paper (C10) available in the University website may be referred.
4. At P.G. level research based project paper shall be a compulsory paper of four (4) credits in all subject areas/disciplines in the final semester effective from 2022 admission batch
5. Besides and beyond the existing course structure of 80 credits at P.G. level, the following course papers shall be additionally taught in all subject areas/disciplines.
 1. Environmental Studies/ Disaster Management for 2 credits in the 1st semester examination.
 2. A MOOC Course for 4 credits in 2nd semester examination, rather all semester.
 3. Open Elective for 2 credits in 3rd semester examination.
 4. Entrepreneurship Development for 2 credits in 3rd semester examination.
6. Apart from this, there shall be Non-credit courses at the P.G. level like YUVASANSKARA. Moreover, a Non-credit course of **NCC/NSS/SPORTS/Performing Arts** may be selected by the students in any one semester course.
