Business Transacted:

1. Considered item No.1- Implementation of "Research and Publication Ethics:
It was resolved that "Research and Publication Ethics (RPE) – 2 Credit Course" will be added in Clause-10 of course structure after Course-615 i.e. Review of Resenrch. The total credit hours of two semesters will be modified as "42Credit Hours" instead of 40 credit Hours and the total credit hours for First Semester will be modified as 22 Credit Hours instead of 20 Credit Hours. This shall be effective for M.Phil and Ph.D course work starting from January 2021.

Accordingly "Research and Publication Ethics(RPE) course No.-616 will be added in Annexure-IA- Transcript, Grade point and Grade point Average secured are as follows: - After "Research Methodology- Course No. 616" of the Ph.D regulation effective from 19th May, 2020. In Annexure-VI- Provisional certificate of the said regulation "and" with "Research and Publication Ethics" will/may be added after this degree is pursued... of UGC Regulations 2016. Both said lines may/will be incorporated in the PCM for M.Phil course

2. Considered item No. 2-Drafting of +3 CBCS UG Regulation as per Model Common UG CBCS Regulation:

Considered the above item and resolved that a committee be constituted for preparing the draft Regulation for UG-CBCS course effective from 2019-20 academic session incorporating all the provisions of the model regulations for under Graduate programme for +3(BA/BCOM/B.Sc) approved by the Academic council in its meeting held on 8.4.2019. The committee shall consist of the following members:

1. Prof. S.R.Mohapatra(Member RAC and Coordinator)
2. Controller of Examinations- Consulting Member
3. Dr. Nabakrushna Behera, P.G.Department of Chemesry
4. Dr. Prayas Dansana, P.G.Department of Law, Sambalpur University
5. Sri Rohit Kumar Mishra, P.G.Department of Business Administration

The Draft Regulation be prepared within a month and be submitted for scrutiny by the RAC.

3. Considered item No.3-Note Sheet from PGCO on course. Work for students who have already completed Ph.D/M.Phil thesis without research.

Considered the above and resolved that a committee will prepare a draft transitory regulation for allowing M.Phil/Ph.D scholars for a course completion certificate those who have completed their course work and under exempted category/ have completed Ph.D. but not having undertaken a course work certificate. The Committee shall consist of Prof. S.R. Mohapatra, Prof. P.K. Naik and Dr. R. Kujur as members. The Draft Regulation will be submitted before the Vice-Chancellor/the Academic Council with approval of the Chairman, P.G.Council.

4. Considered item No.4-Consideration of Correction on BBA (Under CBCS) regulation on Credit Hours.:

Considered item No.4 above and resolved that Cl. NO. 4 of BBA in Regulation be modified. The Course structure both in Regulations and Syllabus be modified as per Annexure-1. The Course Structure both in Regulation and Syllabus be modified as per Annexure-I. Further paper-wise distribution of credits and marks be modified as per Annexure-2. The details of the mark distribution of dissertation and viva (summer internship project) be modified as per Annexure-3. The above modifications are made to follow /satisfy the CBCS norms prescribed by UGC. These modifications may be given effect from 2018-19 academic session.

5. Considered the item no. 5 relating to issue of 'Additional Mark Sheets for 1st and 4th Semester for B.Sc.(Nursing) Examinations'.

Resolved that this may be dealt by the COE taking the help of Computer Unit as per the regulation of B.Sc.(Nursing) and the format provided by the Principal, Sambalpur Nursing College, Sambalpur be approved by the Authority.



- vi. Business & Management Studies


