

Suggestions - Sri S. Choudhury
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- (1) As per state model syllabus a student in U.G. can opt either 2 (two) G.E. subjects with 2 papers for each or 1 (one) G.E. subject with 4 papers

Following ambiguities and difficulties come into play in the course structure of G.E. Physics

- (a) The syllabus for G.E-I, G.E-II ^{and} opting 2 G.E. subjects and one G.E. subject with 4 papers are completely different. Very often the students and sometimes the teachers as well are confused with the syllabus (e.g. proper counselling is not done). The 4-paper G.E. students are mistakenly going through 2-paper G.E. subject.

- (b) In college timetable two (2) different G.E. classes are to be allotted for the same year due to their diff. course structure of the two category

- (c) The syllabus (course) for students opting 2 (two) papers is too vast which includes tough papers like Relativity, Quantum mechanics, Transition etc.

- (d) Till now there is no. Text Books for 2-paper G.E. students. So they have to collect am. notes and study material from a good many Home Books.

- (e) suggestion \rightarrow So the G.E. syllabus in Physics should be same for P-I and P-II in both category should be same.
