The usge statistics by the INFLIBNET centre shows that the e-journal received under the E-Shodhsindhu Consortium to our University has been profusely used. Proquest Provides access to about 13500 e-books, 8,881,831 scholarly articles and 2,241,105 Dissertations and Thesis.
