They are engaged in day today repairing / servicing of different P.G. Department, Central Library, Administrative Block, Hostel, Health Centre, Police out post as per their requirement and requisition facilities / work done. At present the U.S.I.C has two shops like mechanical shops and Electrical Shop. They are maintaining (Log-Book) for details.

(A) Mechanical shops maintains mechanical oriented equipment of the department like vacuum pumps, Gas Chulla, Swing machine, Pressure Cooker and fabricate experimental adds as requisition by the P.G. Department undertaking the repair of ceiling fans of the entire University in very marginal cost. This has earned a tremendous saving for the University in account of maintenance fans. In addition to this shop undertakes repair and fabrication work to the iron doors, windows, cots of the Hostel.

(B) The U.S.I.C also undertakes the maintenance of Electrical installation and Electrical repair of all P.G. Department, E. Gov, Central Office, Central Library and entire University including street lights.


