ABOUT THE SAMBALPUR UNIVERSITY

The Sambalpur University Act was passed by the Odisha Legislature on 10th December, 1966 to fulfill long cherished dream of the people of Western Odisha for establishment of a University. The University started functioning from 1st January, 1967 with Prof. Parsuram Mishra as the first Vice-Chancellor. The University was inaugurated on 4th January, 1967 by Hon'ble Chancellor A.N. Khosla. The University started functioning in 1967 in a rented private building at Dhanupali, Sambalpur and in Government building at Ainthapali, Sambalpur from 1968 - 72. In the year 1973 the University was shifted to the present campus named Jyoti Vihar at Burla. The territorial jurisdiction of the University covers 10 districts of the state of Odisha namely Sambalpur, Sundargarh, Jharsuguda, Deogarh, Bargarh, Bolangir, Subarnapur, Nawapara, Kalahandi, Boudh and Athamallik Sub-Division of Angul District. The University at Jyoti Vihar provides Post-Graduate education in Twenty-seven subjects through Twenty Post-Graduate Departments.

ABOUT THE P.G. DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY

The P.G. Department of History since its inception in 1969 has grown to be one of the largest Departments of Humanities in Sambalpur University. Being a DRS Autonomous Department with rich museum, archives, palm-leaf manuscript library, photo gallery of illustrious sons of West Odisha, archeological facilities and with the dedication of teachers, scholars and students, it has assumed the shape of a big centre of teaching and research in History. Many vital excavations and publications have brought to limelight hitherto unknown facets of history and culture of this region.

ABOUT PROF. N.K. SAHU MUSEUM

The Post Graduate Department of History, Sambalpur University opened its museum in 1970 for collection, preservation and documentation of the invaluable antiquities within a decade it has made considerable progress in the work for which it was started. At present the museum comprises pre-historic tools from different parts of Orissa and Assam, excavated potteries and other archaeological objects from Asurgarh (Kalahandi district) and Manamunda (Phulbani district), some interesting coins and sculptures, copper plate inscriptions ranging from 4th Century A.D. to 19th Century A.D. and a few lithic epigraphs. It has also preserved punch marked coins from Kalahandi district, Puri-Kusana coins from Purusottampur and Bhilingi, Sarabhapuriya gold coins from Nehena (Nuapada district), a few gold coins probably issued by the Chedis and the Kusanas, some gold fanams of the imperial Gangas from Subarnapur, some gold and silver coins of the medieval period, coins of the British-East India Company and princely states as well as a few terracotta seals. War implements of the 19th Century, brass objects of the same period, musical instruments and other objects of the tribal people and painted portraits are some of the interesting collections of the museum.

Full paper of the article should be sent in word file to the Director (histconfsu@gmail.com) on or before **20th March 2018**, for publication in the seminar Proceedings [The article should not be more than 4000 words, Times New Roman font 12-point font, typed in 1.5 spacing on A-4 paper and reference should be in APA format (<http://www.ucl.ac.uk/writing-lab/online-resources/style-guides/apa-style-guide.pdf>)].

Interested participants are also allowed for Poster presentation (dimension 80x60 cm).

Accommodation
