| Abstract of the research work (max. 300 words) | The traditional Indian medicine Ayurveda is still prevailing in our country. People incline towards Ayurvedic medicine because of side effects and high cost of allopathic system of medicine. The traditional medicine is growing rapidly due to the attention being given by governmental agencies and different NGOs. The Indian government recently established the Central Council foe Research in Ayurvedic Sciences, an autonomous body of the Department of Ayurveda, Yoga, and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha, and Homeopathy for the standardization of formulation development and promotion or research into Ayurvedic medicine. A separate Department of Indian system of Medicine and Homoeopathy (ISM &H) was set up in 1995 to propagation of AYUSH systems of health care. The Department of ISM &H was renamed as the Department of AYUSH (Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha, Homoeopathy) in November 2003. On 9th November, 2014, first time Department of AYUSH is formed as a separate ministry known as Ministry of AYUSH. The Ministry of AYUSH promotes and propagates Indian system of medicine and Homoeopathy and traditional medicine. |
