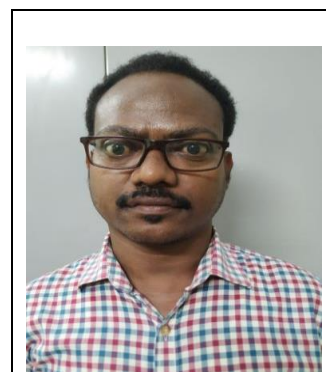

Abstract of the Research Work	Education is considered as one of the most important means of societal transformation. It provides new light and direction for change and development in society. Productivity and poverty reduction of the people largely depends on education. But accessibility of education has been the challenging issue for weaker section of the society like Schedule Tribe. For accessibility and increasing the educational status among tribal, Ashram schools have been established across the tribal inhabited areas. Despite of such initiatives in the form of establishing ashram school, the educational status of tribal community is still lagging behind the general populations since after more than seven decades of independence. The present study is exploratory in nature and aims to find out the role of Ashram school in tribal education in the selected district of Odisha. Considering the larger existence of tribal population and ashram schools, the study will be carried out in one tribal district of Odisha. For that the researcher has selected Sundargarh district to study. The researcher will apply Interview Schedule for collecting primary data. The main focus will be on the stake holders and the facilities they avail in Ashram school. Additional information will be collected from parents, teachers and school management committee.
