Abstract of the Research Work	Migration is a complex phenomenon that involves the movement of people from one place to another due to various reasons, such as employment opportunities, education, or marriage. In Indian context, migration has been an integral part of the socio-economic and cultural fabric of the country since ancient times. The state of Odisha in eastern India has witnessed significant migration patterns, with people moving out of the region for better job prospects and improved living conditions. Data will be collected from both primary and secondary sources and will be carried out in the Khordha district, which is located in the eastern part of Odisha. Though there are few progressive indicators, the select district depicts a very interesting trend of inter-state migration. The study also aims to examine the social security and welfare measures for migrant workers in the state as well as national level.
