Sub:- Eligibility criteria to be a Research Supervisor

Sir.

In inviting reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to say that as per the U.G.C. Guidelines the regular Professors of the Universities are recognised as Research Supervisor. The Professors of the Universities were excluded from active Ph. D. guidance on attaining the age of superannuation. On the other hand, it is noted that guidance by an experienced senior Professor plays a key role for good quality research work.

Government after careful consideration have been pleased to allow the retired Professors of the State Universities, upto 70 years of age, to guide the M. Phil. or Ph. D. Students of the concerned University, subject to condition that they will not claim any remuneration. Thus no financial implication will accrue either to the State Government or to the University on this score.

All other conditions as laid down in the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degrees) Regulations, 2016 shall be applicable.
