About Prof. B. Behera Central Library



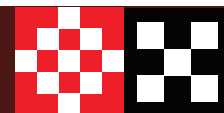
The central library of Sambalpur University was established in the year 1970 after three years of inception of Sambalpur University in 1967. It was named as Professor Bhubaneswar Behera Central Library in the name of the then Vice Chancellor Professor Bhubaneswar Behera who played a crucial role in establishing of this library. The central library, a 3 storied building is spread over 27,450 square feet and comprises large air conditioned reading rooms, digital library with 56 dedicated systems, textbooks and circulation sections, theses and back volume section, and administrative sections. It aims at selecting, acquiring, storing, retrieving and disseminating information for the benefit of academic community of Sambalpur University. Resources of central library comprise of excellent collection of books, reports, journals, theses, and electronic resources. The holdings of the library consist of more than 1.5 Lakhs of books, 13000+ full text e-journals, 2000+ e-books, 33 online databases, and 14777 bound volumes through INFLIBNET One Nation One Subscription and institutional subscription. The library is fully automated with KOHA library management system and integrated with RFID system. The central library is using Dspace software for archiving of institutional publications.

About the National Digital Library of India



The National Digital Library of India (NDLI), an initiative by the Ministry of Education and NMEICT, is a digital repository offering a single-window search for diverse learning resources. Sponsored by the Government of India and developed by IIT Kharagpur, NDLI provides user-specific services for exam preparation, research, and general learning. NDLI aims to enable efficient learning and interlinked exploration from global best practices. 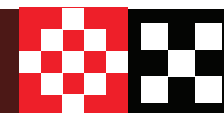

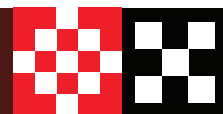
Food and Snacks for the participants during the workshop date 19th September 2025 will be taken care by NDLI.

How to Reach



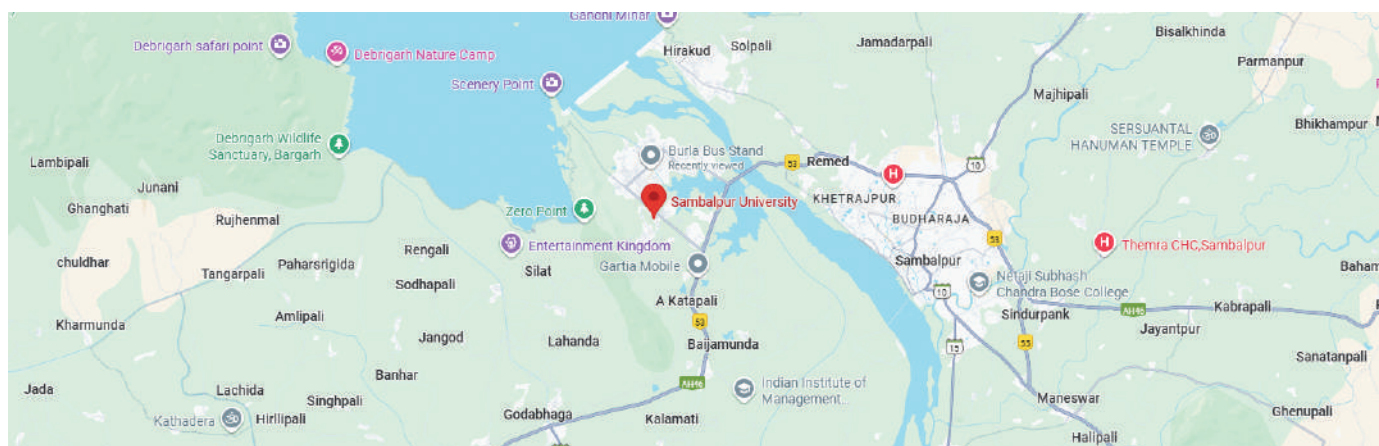
